





- Air Creebec is committed in working and creating partnerships in the region
- Committed to create economic growth in the region
- Air Creebec is embarking on a new mission to provide emergency medical evacuation flights from Northern Quebec. In partnership with Propair Inc. of Rouyn-Noranda, this means patients will receive faster and more timely "medevac" flights to health care facilities in the south.



- The Air Creebec-Propair partnership was chosen to provide the service in a province-wide public tender by the Cree Board of Health and Social Services (CBHSSJB) for emergency flights to Montreal and Val-d'Or.
- The joint venture between Air Creebec and Propair is seen as a natural partners due to their knowledge of the north.



- Joint venture with Propair Inc. created in January 2016.
- Joint venture allows to be more competitive and bring business opportunities to the region
- The joint venture is based on sharing knowledge and resources to provide Air Transport service to the Northern communities. (MEDEVAC)
- Reached an agreement with the Cree Health Board and Social Services of James Bay
